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1. Welcome and Introduction

Participants were warmly welcomed to Herceg Novi for the EDUTRAIN2 training within the VETERANS project. The training gathered partners and experts from the Western Balkans and the EU to strengthen *green skills in VET education* through hands-on sessions, digital tools, and collaboration.

The session began with a brief round of introductions where participants shared:

- Their name,
- Country of origin, and
- One thing they enjoy (a hobby, interest, or source of happiness).

2. Attendance

Participants were reminded to fill in the list of presence to ensure accurate attendance records. In total, 18 participants were part of this training.

3. Platform Testing and Evaluation

- The testing of the EDUTRAIN digital platform was conducted during the training.
- It was noted that the platform currently experiences an error at 85% progress, preventing full completion.
- The minimum passing score for the training was agreed to be **80%**.
- Each partner is responsible for ensuring 30 participants per country complete the platform.

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- It was agreed that 25 participants completing the platform and 30 completing the Google evaluation form will fulfill the required data submission.

4. Certificates

- The certificate template will be designed in Canva for all participants who successfully complete the training and evaluation process.
- Fifty-Fifty will send the 2-3 examples in CANVA link and later will give them to IT experts and the

- It was reported that on the VETERANS project website, in the section partnership, the Romanian partner organization is not hyperlinked, it opens a different website.
- Additionally, **CeP is not listed** on the website. The issue will be communicated to the coordinator for correction.

6. Multiplier Event

- The partners discussed the possibility of sharing the EDUTRAIN platform during the multiplier events to demonstrate the developed tools and outcomes.

8. Final Meeting and Final conference

- The final project meeting and conference will be held in Skydra, Thessaloniki (Greece).
- Each organization will send two representatives.
- The coordinating organization will inform all partners regarding flight bookings and logistics.

8. Evaluation of the EDUTRAIN2

A total of 18 participants from Montenegro, Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Greece, and Kosovo took part in the evaluation of the EDUTRAIN2 training in Herceg Novi. The feedback demonstrates a high level of satisfaction with the organization, content, and relevance of the activities. Most participants rated the training with 4 or 5 (Agree or Strongly Agree) in terms of overall satisfaction and learning outcomes. The majority highlighted the testing and presentation of the VETERANS digital platform, networking activities, and interactive workshops as the most valuable parts of the program. Participants particularly appreciated the collaborative environment, the hospitality of the hosts, and the opportunity for cultural exchange and professional networking. Many noted that the city tours of Herceg Novi and Kotor added cultural depth and helped strengthen team spirit among participants. Only minor technical issues were reported, such as the platform stopping at 85% completion, which will be addressed before the next phase of implementation. No significant problems were noted in the logistics or organization. Overall, participants described the training as very well organized, engaging, and practically oriented, emphasizing that it provided new experiences, useful knowledge on green skills, and a strong basis for continued cooperation between partner organizations.

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
